The problem most likely is that you have cookies and site data disabled. In Chrome I fixed this problem by going to: Settings-->Show Advanced Settings (at the bottom)-->Content Settings
Uncheck: Block third-party cookies and site data

HuffPost only allows verified facebook accounts to post comments. That means you have to put a phone # in your facebook account (not visible, just there.) That's what HuffPost's rules say. You might be able to post but if anyone there 'reports' your post, which anyone who disagrees with it probably will for petty reasons...then it seems to end with a blacklisting.

My personal Facebook ID seem to have gotten blacklisted after I posted comments which were "too Christian" on a couple of liberal websites. However, I can still post comments using my small business ID.

At the bottom of the Social Plugin comment form, it says:

Posting as {my name} (Change)

If I click "(Change)" then it lets me select between my name (my personal Facebook ID). Posting comments on news articles works fine if I use my business name. Posting them with my personal Facebook ID does not work.

My guess is that someone who disagreed with one of my Christian comments -- perhaps a moderator on a liberal web site -- falsely reported me to Facebook as violating some policy, and Facebook then blacklisted me on ALL sites.

Are you sure your personal id ever really worked for posting comments to articles? I use to "think" mine worked, until I discovered that no one but I could see my comments, and that after I logged out of FB even "I" couldn't see them. That's not exactly correct. When I post a comment using my small business ID, it SEEMS to succeed, and the direct link to the comment (which the comment's time links to) will work indefinitely, for me. However, using that link while logged in is the ONLY way to view that comment. To everyone else, the comment is missing, regardless of whether they use the direct link to the comment, and even from my own account, the comment is missing unless I use the direct link to it.

So FB is censoring comments from both my personal ID and my linked small business ID, but in two different ways.

Using a different (seldom-used) Facebook account, I encountered yet a third mode of censorship. With that account, if I post a comment it appears to work, and remains visible as long as I'm logged in on that account, regardless of whether I use the direct link to the comment or just view all the comments on the story. However the comment is invisible to everyone else unless they use the direct link to the comment. If other people use the direct link to the comment, they can see it, but if they just view all the comments on the story then the comment disappears.

So that's three different censorship modes that Facebook is using.
